Transport

Aim: To improve pupil safety

Eco-Schools Topic: Waste

Aim: To compost food waste.

Action(s): To purchase a
compost bin for the garden.

Learn what waste can be
composted.

Eco-council pupils take
compostable food waste
out.

How long will it take? 1 term
(but it may have to wait until
the garden is built)

Who is responsible? Each
Eco-council member in the
class.

How we will monitor
progress: We will measure
the amount of compost
gathered in the season.

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Eco-Schools Topic: Marine

Aim: To ban single use plastics being used in school.

Action(s): To audit what single use plastics are used.
To introduce reusable bags for pack lunches and school trips.
To ban single use plastics in lessons.
To audit whether the purchase of plastics has declined.

How long will it take? 2 terms.

Who is responsible? Eco-council members.

How we will monitor progress: We will count how many children bring reusable bags on a school trip.
We will audit how many plastics are purchased.
Evaluation:

Eco-Schools Topic: Litter

Aim: To reduce litter in the playground.

Action(s): To reduce waste coming into school with messages in assembly and SMP.
To have a litter picking rota of Eco-councillors each day.

How long will it take? Implemented immediately but could take a few weeks to see a change in the amount of litter.
